

Spa Six Hours Meeting Thursday 25th – Saturday 27th September 2025

Here are the detailed final instructions and HGPCA information for the Spa Six Hours meeting. There are some changes to the usual procedures so please do read the attached detailed Logbook carefully. In addition, please note the attached document **READ ME Circuit Information** which details the circuit's mandatory regulations. If you have any questions, come back to us and we'll do our best to answer them.

Entry List

The entry list is attached. Please let us know at your earliest opportunity if there are any amendments to be made. Race numbers will be available in the Red Truck.

Circuit Access & Vehicle Passes

All competitor and team access to the circuit is via the Blanchimont Gate which will be open 24 hours from 20.00 on Tuesday until 21.00 on Sunday.

To access the circuit, you must download and either print the attached HGPCA Access Pass or have it available to show on your phone.

The officials on the gate will attach the relevant vehicle pass to your windscreen. All occupants of the vehicle will be given wristbands which are your access passes for the weekend.

Access to the Paddock and F1 Pit Garages will be as follows:

Tuesday 24th September from 20.30 to 22.30

Wednesday 25th and Thursday 26th September from 07.00 to 22.30

Garages

HGPCA have been allocated garages in the F1 Pit Building. There is a charge of €70 per car, payable direct to the organisers **not** to HGPCA. Payment should be made to Anne or Kathleen in Room 115 when you go to sign on.

Please note that garage space for a car racing in any other grid is charged at €200 per car. <u>The garage plan</u> will follow later this week once it's been agreed with Roadbook

Signing-on

Signing on takes place in Room 115 on Wednesday 24th September from 08.00 to 11.45am and 12.30 to 18.30. and on Thursday 25th September from 08.00 until 13.20 (60 minutes prior to Qualifying).

Scrutineering of Driver Kit

When you sign on, you will be given your scrutineering form for your Safety Equipment. Take this, together with all your kit (helmet, FHR, overalls, gloves, shoes etc) to Room 127 (1st Floor F1 Pit Building) to be checked.

On Wednesday 24th September from 08.00 to 11.45am and 12.30 to 18.30. and on Thursday 25th September from 08.00 until 13.10 (60 minutes prior to Qualifying)

The last section of the attached Logbook details the minimum equipment that the RACB require to compete in Belgium – check that your kit complies!

Please especially take note of the section on Frontal Head Restraint (FHR) which is mandatory for <u>Period F</u> cars. For Period E cars and earlier the use of FHR is strongly recommended.

Scrutineering of Race Cars

Bertie Gilbart-Smith will be scrutineering all HGPCA cars in their F1 Garages from 14.00 until 18.30 on Wednesday, and from 08.30 until 13.10 on Thursday.

<u>Transponders</u>

AMB Transponders are available to hire from Room 115. Hire charge is €30 payable on site in cash or by credit card.

Tyres & Race Fuel

Drivers Briefing

The mandatory Drivers Briefing is on Thursday at 12.45 in Room 132 (1st Floor F1 Pit Building). Please either advise the officials at signing on or one of the HGPCA Team on site if you're unable to attend this briefing. There is a €250 fine for non-attendance.

Start Procedure/Assembly Area

Will be a 2x2 formation Rolling Start. The Clerk of the Course has once again kindly given us permission to assemble in the Pit Lane for both races. We ask that you remain in your garage to be called forward in grid order by the Pit Lane Marshals and the HGPCA Team.

Noise

HGPCA sessions will be unsilenced.

Mechanical Failures

If you fail to complete either Qualifying or Race 1, please speak to either Lindsey or Chris as soon as possible and let us know whether the car is being withdrawn or will be repaired and able to start after any issues. We can then get the grid for the next session re-issued.

Motorhomes & Caravans – Pre-book

Must be **pre-booked** using the attached form which should be returned to Roadbook as indicated on the form together with your payment of €50. The Motorhome Village will have toilets, water and waste provision and limited electric hook-ups available on a first come, first served basis. No motorhomes will be allowed into the circuit unless you have pre-booked and paid. Motorhomes will not be allowed to park outside the F1 garages under any circumstances.
