#### Event Information

##### MRL HQ

The Motor Racing Legends HQ will be located in the main paddock at Charade and will be where the MRL Team will be based throughout the race weekend should you need any assistance during the weekend.

##### Paddock Access Times

Access to the paddocks for the Trophées D'Auvergne will be available from 13:00 on Thursday 9 July. All MRL race entries will be based in the main paddock and have their own tent allocation with its own power supply.

## CIRCUIT DE CHARADE

Circuit de Charade is located near Clermont-Ferrand in the Auvergne region of central France.

#### BY ROAD

**From Clermont-Ferrand** (approx. 20 km / 25 mins):

- Take the D2089 towards Pontaumur / Mont-Dore
- Follow signs for "Circuit de Charade"
- Turn right onto Route de Manson (D943)
- Follow the road up to the circuit entrance

**From A75 Motorway:**

- Take exit 5 towards Clermont-Ferrand
- Follow the D2089 towards Pontaumur
- Follow signs for "Circuit de Charade"

Access will be via the circuit main gate on first arrival on Thursday.

As a reminder, vans, trailers and gazebos are not permitted in the MRL paddock and should be parked in the dedicated trailer parking (please see paddock map for trailer parking location).

### Paddock Arrival Procedure

On arrival at the circuit, all Team vehicles will be met by the MRL Paddock Team and guided to their allocated paddock space for unloading.

Trucks should be parked in a specific zone near to the paddock entrance.

Cars and vans with trailers will be permitted direct access to the paddock to unload vehicles and equipment before moving their trailers to the dedicated parking area.

Vehicles will not be admitted directly through the paddock gate during the meeting (see Paddock Plan for details). There will be no Paddock access after 21:00 each day.



## Competitors

From Friday morning onwards, personal vehicles must use the MRL Competitor Parking located Route de Manson – see paddock plan below.

## Entry Tickets

Each MRL Entry will receive 6 weekend entry passes. Tickets will be available:

Thursday	15:00-20:00	MRL HQ in the main paddock.
Friday	08:00-20:00	MRL HQ in the main paddock.

## Vehicle Passes

Vehicle passes will not be sent in advance and will be issued on arrival at the circuit. Only genuine race support vehicles will be permitted within the paddock.

## Motorhome Parking

A dedicated motorhome area will be available within the paddock (see area on Paddock Plan above) If you have booked your motorhome in already, please speak to the MRL Paddock Team who will guide you to your allocated space on arrival. If you intend to bring a motorhome and have not booked your space yet, please complete the motorhome booking form by the Extras options on the [MRL Web Portal](#)

## Trailer Parking

All trailers must be parked in the dedicated secure trailer parking area. The MRL Paddock Team will assist with trailer removal and positioning where required.

Space within the paddock is limited, so we ask all teams to assist by moving trailers promptly to the designated area.

## Sporting Information

### Friday morning Test Sessions – 10 July

Sign-on for the Practice Sessions will be in person in the reception area of the Control Tower from 08:00. Drivers will need to show their license and collect a wristband before going on track.

The Friday morning test sessions are not noise restricted.

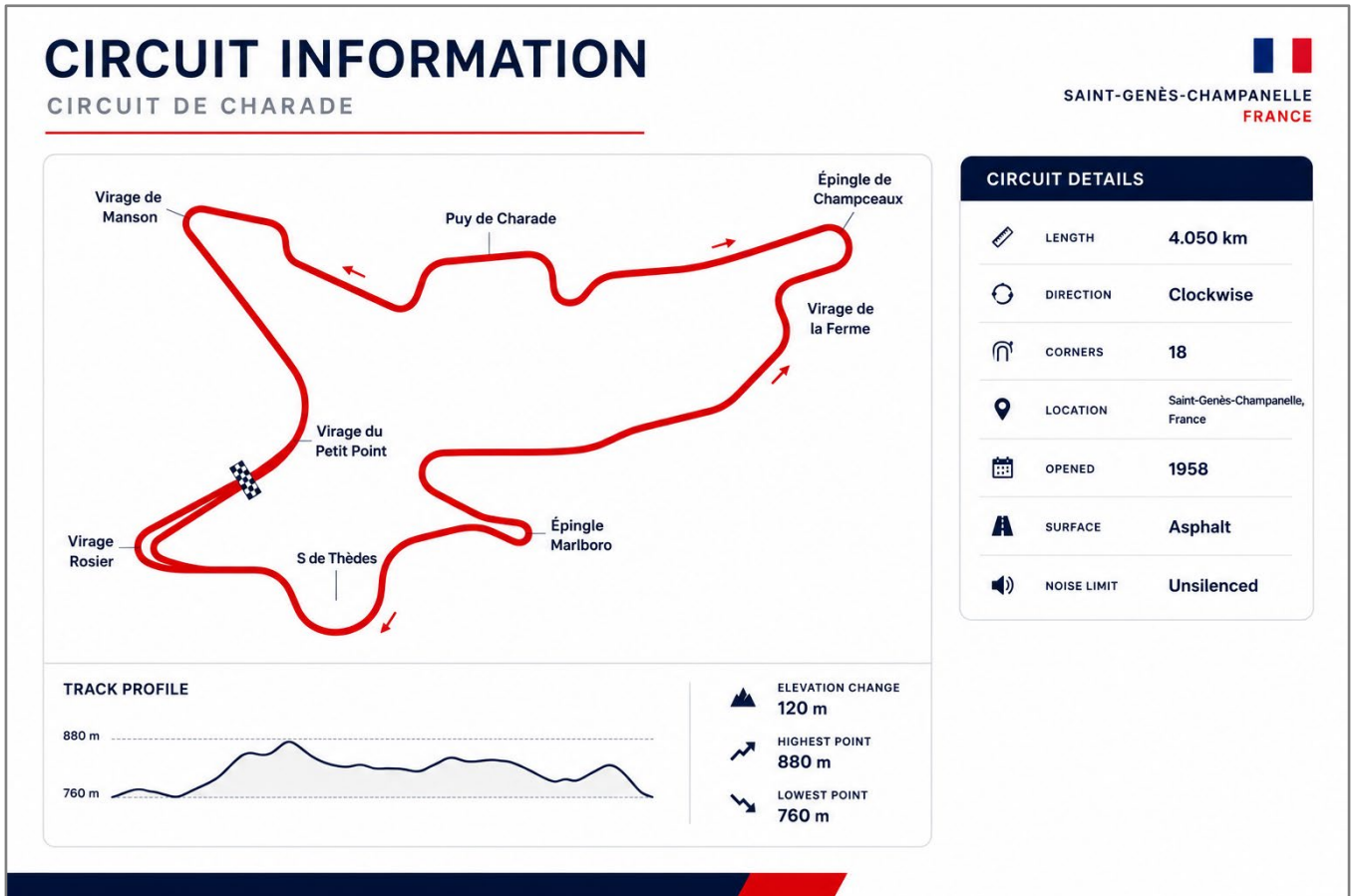

## Transponders

Timing will be operated using TAG transponders only. MyLaps transponders will not work. TAG transponders are available to hire from the timekeeping room at the circuit (In Race Control tower) for 60€.

We will also be trialling an RFID system at Charade. All MRL drivers will be given an RFID identity strip at sign-on that should be attached to their helmets. The RFID system will allow us to know which driver is in the car at any one time.
